Ranford Pool Walk Trail

Where: 2 River Road, Ranford

The local Friends of the Reserves have created a lovely walk trail that starts from the Lions Weir and takes you along to the historical Ranford Pool.

Tullis Bridge/ Tullis Walk Trail

The 16km return walk trail from Boddington to Tullis Bridge follows the Rail Reserve, passing along the river, paddocks, and timber reserves. At Tullis Bridge, enjoy a picnic, relax under trees by the Hotham River, and explore a 3km loop trail around the bridge and river. Toilets are available at the site.
